All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries are to be mailed to: **CAPER, 24902 Apple Rd, Waterford WI 53185-4832.**

Entries must be received by 6:00 pm Wednesday, February 3, 2010 after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows published by the American Kennel Club.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will have the entry cancelled; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$20 administrative fee, are paid via certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature. **Entries received without signature release will be returned.**

Entries with email addresses will be acknowledged with an email receipt. CAPER is not responsible for non-delivery of emails due to delivery errors or spam blockers, and no further efforts will be made. Confirmations and judging schedules will be sent via regular mail after closing.

**Refunds:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds will be made, less \$8 per day, for bitches entered in obedience who come into season after the closing date, if a veterinarian's certificate is presented to the secretary prior to the start of obedience classes.

**Fax/email entries:** Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830 or scanned and emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. Both the front and back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted. A copy of the entry fee check must also be faxed/emailed at the same time as the entries. Entry forms with fees must be mailed with a postmark no later than February 3, 2010, and received no later than February 6, or the entry will not be accepted. Entry fees must include a **\$2.00 charge per entry form submitted**. **Payment by credit card will not be accepted.**

**Entry Errors:** Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. All entries which include an email address will be sent an entry verification email shortly after receipt. All errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of less than \$5 will not be refunded.

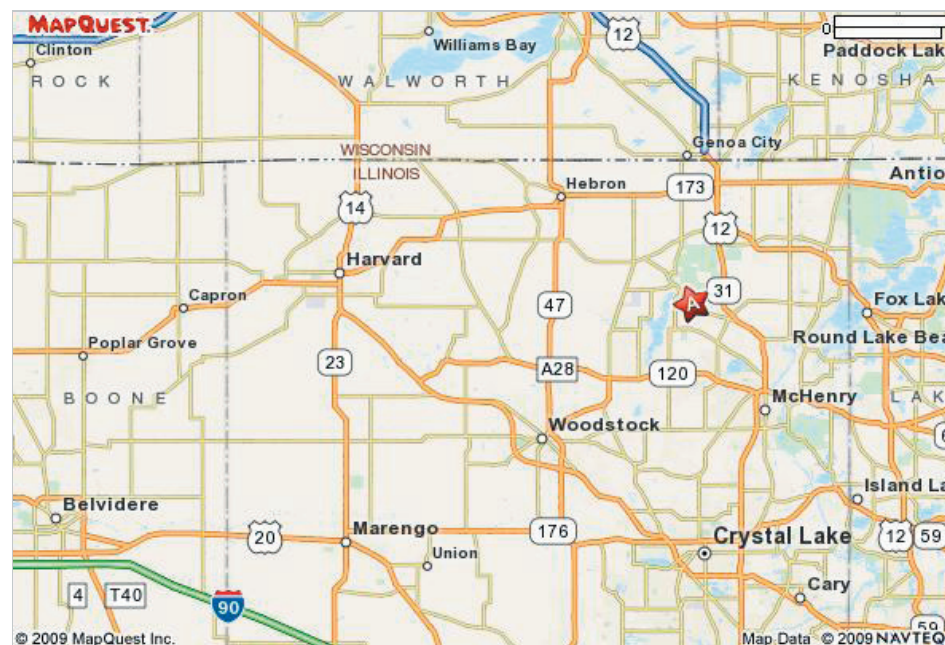
## DIRECTIONS TO SITE

## PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Puppy Sweepstakes is open to all Collie dogs/bitches who are at least 6 months of age and under 18 months of age on the day of the Sweepstakes. All dogs and bitches entered in Sweepstakes MUST ALSO be entered in a Regular Class at this Specialty, at the regular entry fee. **Any puppy placing in sweepstakes and not shown in the Regular Classes, unless excused by the veterinarian, will be subject to forfeiture of all sweepstakes awards and prizes.** Entries must be made at the same time and on the same entry form as the regular classes, indicating in the space for "Additional Classes" the entry in Sweepstakes. Rough and smooth coats will be combined in the classes.

### DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY

10% of total entry fees are retained by club for expenses. The remaining stake is divided as follows:

Best in Sweeps - 15% of total entry      Best of Opposite Sex - 8% of total entry

Balance will be divided among the winners in each class as follows (percentages are based on the total entry fees for each class): First Prize-30% • Second Prize- 20% • Third Prize- 15% • Fourth Prize- 10%

## SITE INFORMATION

Due to facility regulations, no exercise pens will be allowed indoors at any time. Exercise pens will be allowed outdoors in designated areas only. Exercise areas for the dogs will also be allowed only in designated areas.

**Important: Tarps are required under your grooming area and must be taped down.** If you do not have a tarp, a limited number of tarps will be available for purchase. Crates may be required to be stacked at the discretion of the club.

According to AKC regulations, only dogs eligible to be shown under AKC rules are allowed in the show building. Due to space limitations, the show committee reserves the right to restrict the presence of unentered dogs from inside the show building.

### EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CLEANING UP AFTER THEMSELVES & THEIR DOGS!

Parking will be allowed in the grass area designated parking lot only.

Complimentary coffee and donuts will be available until the start of sweepstakes judging. Soda and water will be for sale the entire day. Lunch will be available for purchase during normal lunch times.

Please turn all cell phones or pagers to Silent before entering the ring area.

**HEALTH NOTICE:** Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, & have appropriate vaccinations. All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against Central States Collie Club or its members in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

**LIABILITY:** It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such cases, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The club and its agents, employees, etc. will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, & further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

**RINGSIDE:** Dogs may arrive at any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused. Judges will not wait for any dog. Owners and agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs at ringside when their class is called. The club, judges, stewards and secretary have no obligation or responsibility to announce for or locate dogs that are not at ringside when required.

**CATALOGS:** Catalogs are \$4 each if pre-ordered on entry form. A limited number of catalogs will be available during the show for \$5 each.

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed or member show. The Novice class is divided:

Novice Junior - 9 years and under 12 years on the day of the show;  
Novice Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years on the day of the show;  
Novice Senior - 15 years and under 18 years on the day of the show.

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed or member show. The Open class is divided:

Open Junior - 9 years and under 12 years on the day of the show;  
Open Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years on the day of the show;  
Open Senior - 15 years and under 18 years on the day of the show.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

- (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering; i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color); Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.); Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wire-haired); Bull Terriers (colored, white); Manchester Terriers (standard, toy); Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat); Poodles (toy, miniature, standard); Collie (rough, smooth); English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered & shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for a trial closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner, it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any trial for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on the entry form whether transfer application has been made to AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
