

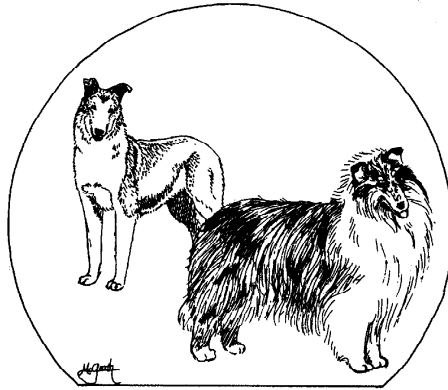

An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked "Brace Class" in the space provided for Additional Classes. The entry fee for Brace Class is \$25.00 for the Brace, regardless of whether either dog is entered in an additional class.

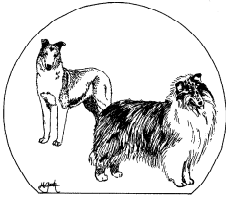

Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. Rough and Smooth Collies will be shown in the same classes in the sweepstakes.

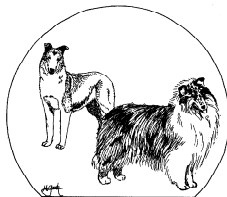
FEE: \$10.00 or no charge if also entered in regular class. AKC Junior Handler Numbers are now required for entry in Junior Showmanship Competition. Numbers may be obtained from the American Kennel Club: Phone: (919) 816-3776.

- **Novice JUNIOR Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show.
- **Novice INTERMEDIATE Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show.
- **Novice SENIOR Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show

*In addition to age requirements, all Novice Class entrants, at the time entries close, must **not** have won three First Place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.*

- **Open INTERMEDIATE Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show.
- **Open SENIOR Class:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

*In addition to age requirements, all Open Class entrants, at the time entries close, **must** have won three First Place awards in a Novice Class in a licensed or member show, with competition present.*

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting there from, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOGS! We want to be able to continue to enjoy this show site.

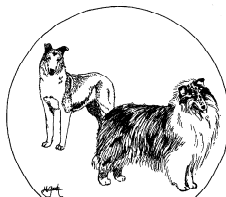
1. Entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed, except as provided for in Ch. 11, Sec. 6 of the Dog Show Rules.
2. Mail all entries, with fees payable to TCCBA, to the Show Secretary before the closing date. Entries must be made on an official AKC Entry Form (or copy), with agreement and rules on reverse side to be accepted. Conditional, telephone, telegraph and unsigned entries will not be accepted. Entries will not be accepted without fees. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Owners are responsible for errors on entry forms. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
3. AN EVENT AND RECORDING FEE of \$2.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show. This recording fee is to be collected by the Show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. Entries will not be accepted if received without fees!
4. This Show will be open from 8 AM to 5 PM. CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM for time of judging.
5. JUDGES ARE NOT REQUIRED TO WAIT for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged.
6. DOGS NOT REQUIRED for further judging will be excused. ENTRY FEE shall not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, excused by the judge or veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.
7. ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash except when being judged or in the exercising ring.
8. NO SPACE WILL BE PROVIDED for un-entered dogs at this show.
9. Surrender of identification card must be made to the clerk when requested, for removing dogs from the show.
10. Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before judging of the breed is over, and the Show Secretary advised at once. The Show Secretary and the show-giving club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
