Novice Junior Class: for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class: for boys and girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first places, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class: for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three first places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class: for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three first places in a Novice class, with competition present, at licensed or member show.

Open Intermediate Class: for boys and girls who are at least 12 years and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three first places, with competition present in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Open Senior Class: for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three first places, with competition present in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC Eukanuba National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

Telegraph, telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official AKC entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not acceptable.

Entries will be mailed as soon as practical. Should an acknowledgment not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable amount of time, please notify the Show Secretary.

A recording fee of .50 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, obedience trial or tracking test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show giving club in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Sec2). Also a \$3.00 AKC event service fee will be required.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent or disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. In obedience competition there will be no refund for bitches in season. If because of riots or civil disturbances or other acts beyond control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry will be made.

Declination of entries: Hunterdon Hills Collie Club, Inc. may decline any entry for cause and may remove any dog due to disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the Hunterdon Hills Collie Club or any official thereof.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a cash only basis.

Errors on entry blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms. Whoever may make such errors, and no entry will be refunded in event of such error or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No refund for duplicate entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. They will adhere as closely as possible to the judging schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The show giving club and show secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

No space for unentered dogs will be provided.

No private exercise pens are allowed inside the building.

Class cash prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for cash prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over, and the show secretary advised at once. The show secretary and the club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

Notice: Effective for all shows held after July 1, 1980, dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the show secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular confirmation judging at the show.
